In 2022, an estimated **934,433** Australians registered for a **Clean Up Australia Day** Event at over **2,474 Clean Up Sites** right around the country, donating more than **1,868,886 hours** of their own time.

Can I take this opportunity to congratulate **Eagleby Bushcare** who every single year put this fantastic initiative on for the community to get involved with, so we can continue to clean up our environment...

And secondly, can I thank **Cleanaway Australia** who went above and beyond, waiving the disposal fees for any **Clean Up Australia** bags that were delivered to their facilities across the entire weekend.
